

Notes on compliance with the legal requirements according to ElektroG in accordance with WEEE

The Electrical and Electronic Equipment Act (ElektroG) implements the EU's WEEE Directive in Germany in dealing with electrical waste. The law obliges manufacturers and distributors of electrical appliances to dispose of old electrical appliances in accordance with certain ecological standards.

Possibility to return and dispose of old appliances

In order to fulfil our responsibility according to § 7a ElektroG3, we ask you to contact us to receive your old appliances and to ensure their reuse or disposal.

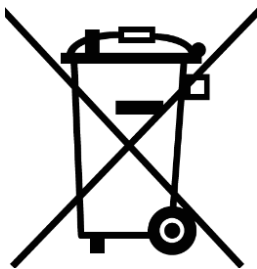
We will inform you of a municipal collection point or a disposal company in your area which will accept your old appliance free of charge. If this is not possible, we offer you the option of returning your old appliance to us free of charge.

Personal responsibility with regard to the deletion of personal data

If the old electrical- or electronic equipment contains personal data, you are responsible for deleting it yourself before returning it.

Meaning of the symbol for the marking of electrical appliances

The symbol of the crossed-out dustbin indicates that this electrical or electronic equipment must not be disposed of with household waste at the end of its life, but must be taken for separate collection by the end user.
